- Citizen of the United States, 18 years or older.
- Resident of Texas and Smith County for at least 30 days immediately prior to the day of election.
- Resident of city or district for 30 days if voting in city or special election district.
- Holder of a valid Voter Registration Certificate at least 30 days prior to election.

- Online at http://www.votexas.org/register_to_vote.html
- At a county substation or at any state agency or public library or by an authorized deputy registrar.
- By an agent: husband, wife, father, mother, son or daughter, if the relative is a qualified voter.

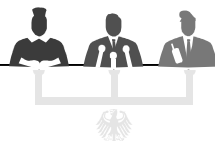

Single-Member Districts

Under single member election systems, an area is divided into a number of geographically defined voting districts, each represented by a single elected official. Voters can vote only for their district's representative, with the highest vote-getter winning election, even if he or she has received less than half of the vote.

Several Smith County government entities elect through an **at-large system**, whereby the electorate of the entire locality or district votes for all members of a multi-member body.
